

# **Basic facts about North Devon**





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This report provides a summary of the latest available information on the demographic and socio-economic make-up of North Devon District in Devon county. It looks at the population structure and provides information on the economic, housing and educational achievement of each ward.

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
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# **Geography and population**

North Devon is one of the 8 districts of Devon. It has an area of  $\underline{110,474.80}$  hectares which represents  $\underline{16.65\%}$  of the total area of Devon county .



# Residents

The resident population of North Devon in 2021 was  $\underline{98,611}$  which represents  $\underline{12.15\%}$  of the total Devon county resident population of  $\underline{811,640}$ .

North Devon's resident population is 50,593 (51.3%) female and 48,018 (48.7%) male.

The total population of N Devon is projected to be 102,289 by 2039.

N Devon has  $\underline{3,597}$  households with dependent children aged 0 to 4. That represents  $\underline{8.33\%}$  of the district's households.  $\underline{10,497}$  households in the district have dependent children of all ages. That represents  $\underline{24.30\%}$  of the district's households.




# Age

The predominant age band in North Devon in 2023 was 55 - 59 with  $\frac{7,721 \text{ people}}{2000 \text{ people}}$  out of the total population of  $\frac{100,543}{2000 \text{ people}}$ .

In 2023 North Devon had <u>16,543 people</u> aged under 16 (representing <u>16.5%</u> of the total population) and <u>26,320 people</u> aged 65+ (representing <u>26.2%</u> of the total population)

#### Population (unrounded) broken down by age band (5 year bands) (count) (Count) (2023) for N Devon






# **Ethnicity**


The largest ethnic group in N Devon in 2021 was White with  $\underline{97.0\%}$  of the district's population. That compares with a figure of  $\underline{96.4\%}$  for Devon county as a whole and  $\underline{93.1\%}$  for South West .

The second largest ethnic group was Mixed race with  $\underline{1.2\%}$  of the district's population. That compares with  $\underline{1.4\%}$  for the county as a whole and  $\underline{2.0\%}$  for South West.



#### Households

In 2021 North Devon district had  $\underline{43,197}$  households, which represent  $\underline{12.25\%}$  of the  $\underline{352,620}$  Devon county's households. The household split by tenure is shown below.




The largest number of households in N Devon lives in Owns outright accommodation with  $\underline{41.8\%}$  of households. That compares with  $\underline{42.2\%}$  for Devon county as a whole and  $\underline{37.7\%}$  for South West.



The second largest number of households lives in Owns with a mortgage or loan accommodation with  $\underline{25.5\%}$  of the district's households. That compares with  $\underline{26.0\%}$  for the county as a whole and  $\underline{28.2\%}$  for South West.

The chart below shows the breakdown of households by size (number of people) for North Devon.






# **Employment**



In N Devon the Overall employment rate (aged 16-64) in 2024 Q2 (12 months ending) was  $\overline{75.3\%}$  compared to  $\overline{78.5\%}$  in Devon and  $\overline{79.0\%}$  in South West. The chart above provides a breakdown of North Devon district by occupation for all residents aged 16 – 64 in 2021 Q4 (12 months ending).



# **Education**




<u>28.54%</u> of North Devon's residents have achieved level 4 qualifications and above compared to <u>32.87%</u> in Devon and <u>33.08%</u> in South West as a whole.

 $\underline{17.76\%}$  of North Devon's residents have no qualifications compared to  $\underline{15.56\%}$  in Devon and  $\underline{15.65\%}$  in South West.



#### Health



In 2021 North Devon had  $\underline{4,352}$  ( $\underline{4.4\%}$ ) residents that reported being in bad health and  $\underline{1,265}$  ( $\underline{1.3\%}$ ) residents that reported being in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 7 (out of 8 Districts) within Devon.
