<p><b>1.</b>To add additional areas for licensable activities internally and on both the patios, deck and lawn as indicated on the submitted plan, to be restricted to Monday to Sunday until 22:30 hours. <b>2.</b> To allow the sale of alcohol on and off the premises to residents and their bona fida guests only. <b>3.</b> Licensable activities internally will be as per the existing licence, except for the amendments made to Condition 13 to read: i)...the performance of live or recorded entertainment will be subject to a maximum non-continuous duration of 6 hours between the hours of 11:30-21:00 (ii) other than in accordance with Condition (i), the performance of recorded music will only be played on the terrace between the hours of 12:00-21:30. To amend condition 17 to read: That, save for the North facing bifold doors which shall remain locked after 22:00 all other external doors and windows shall be kept shut from 22:00 when regulated entertainment is being provided in the premises except for people entering and exiting the premises. To add to condition 3: (viii) any noise complaints received by the hotel, detailing date and time of complaint, nature of the complaint, who the complaint was made by, and to, and any remedial action taken to address the issue.</p>
